




# LOCATIONS

He is the Creative Director of Dopamine, where he ensures the quality, coherence and originality of the visual production work. As part of the content team, he assists the writers from the get-go, making every written letter translate into a better on-screen result. His 14 years of experience as a television editor and producer (Todo va bien [Mandarina Producciones], Lo sabe, no lo sabe [Mandarina Producciones], Hermano Mayor [Plural], Otra Movida [7 and Action]), commercials for brand networks such as Adidas/Real Madrid, Samsung, Microsoft and musical works (Iván Ferreiro, Rozalén, Alba Messa, Fredi Leis) is only a first point of view that complements his expertise in creating graphic and marketing campaigns (Big Bang Media, La Competencia, Señor Mono, Dopamine) and the creation of fiction formats. He has currently been part of the team of directors of the Mexican version of Superstore, Supertitlán., Cóyotl and Reina Roja.









We have been the production company for the series Hernán (2019), an epic, ambitious, and high-budget drama about the arrival of the Spanish conqueror Hernán Cortés to the territories that now form part of Mexico, which premiered on Amazon Prime, History, and TV Azteca. We have also produced the family drama Amarres (2019), the black comedy Búnker (2021, Warner Bros. Discovery / HBO Max, nominated for an Emmy for Best Comedy); created and developed the thriller Tu parte del Trato (2019), and recently premiered our first unscripted, the social experimentation dating show 40 No es nada (2021, Warner Bros. Discovery / HBO Max).

We have been producing internationally for three years. We co-produced **Close to me** (2021) with Nent Studios UK for Channel 4 and **Granite Harbour** (2022) for BBC One and BBC Scotland, as well as the youth series **Campamento Newton** (2022) for Disney with Grupo Secuoya and the workplace comedy **Supertitlán** (adaptation of the American format Superstore) with Universal Studio Group (2022). In addition to developing several projects in Europe with BLACK BOX (Exwife), SYRREAL (Ze Network), White Lions (Maroni, Deep Fear), in association with distributors such as Eccho Rights, All 3 Media, Lionsgate, Nent Studios, Off The Fence, or Leonine.

Currently, we have finished our first American film Home Delivery (2022), in co-production with Les Spoirs, and we are in the post-production phase of two of the most ambitious original series in Mexico and Spain: Cóyotl (2023, Warner Bros. Discovery / HBO Max) and Reina Roja (2023, Amazon Prime), respectively.
